- LTCY 780P is a pre-requisite to LTCY 782P; LTCY 782P is a pre-requisite to LTCY 784P; all three are pre-requisite to LTCY 786P.
- Tuition is at the Professional Development student rate of 50% full tuition. The Professional Development rate for Academic Year 2009-2010 is currently \$213 per credit hour.
- A maximum of 9 quarter credit hours (6 semester credit hours) may be transferred to the UC TESL Program from another university. Courses must be comparable in content and credit hours.
