 Focuses on teaching multilingual learners in PK-12 schools (12 credit hours)
- Teaching English as an Additional Language (TEAL) Graduate Certificate
 Focuses on teaching ESL to adults in diverse settings (15 credit hours)

Graduate degrees and certificates are classified as code 13.1401, Teaching English as a Second or Foreign Language. This code identifies programs that focus on "principles and practices of teaching English to students who are not proficient in English or who do not speak, read or write English" and that prepare "individuals to function as teachers and administrators in such programs" (Institute of Education Sciences).
